This themed edition will be linked to the 2007 Journalism Education Association of NZ conference at Massey University, Wellington, December 10-12, and examine and critique 'The future for the mainstream: The changing demands on journalists and the challenge for the journalism educators'. The editors will be especially interested in articles or commentaries exploring themes such as:

- The role of media, convergence and the internet.
- Maori and other indigenous peoples' media
- Political reporting
- Asian, Pacific, and other cultures' media
- Women in the media
- Cost cutting and rationalisation, and their impact on journalism
- Society's changing expectations of the media
